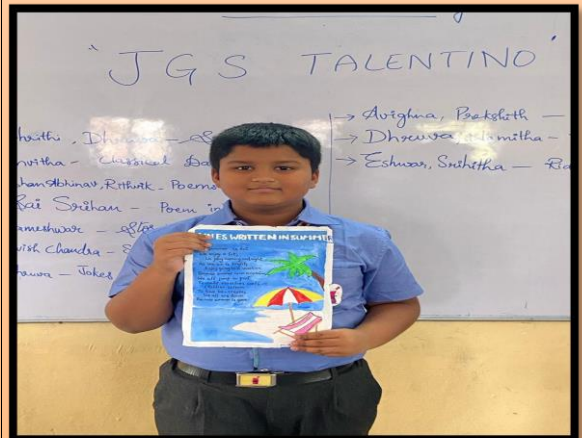
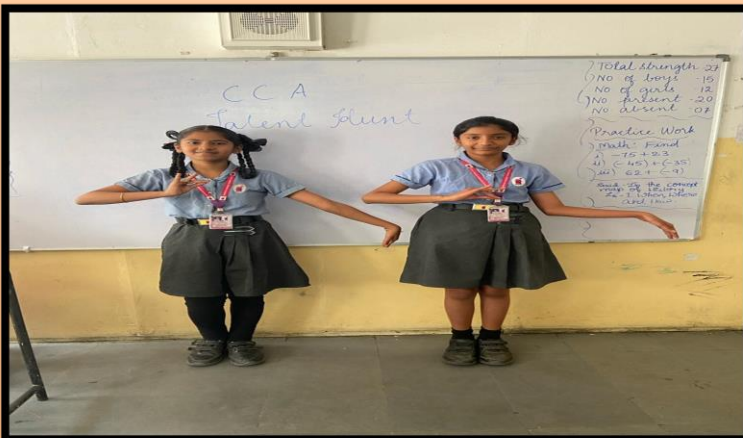
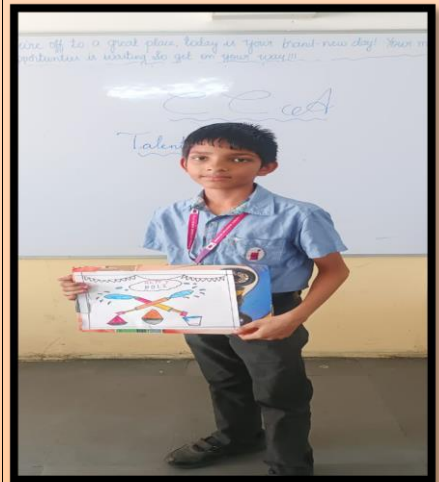
TALENTINO

Students of JGS showed the importance of protecting our home through a skit and presentation in the special assembly. They also provided solutions for issues such as climate change, global warming, extinction of some species.

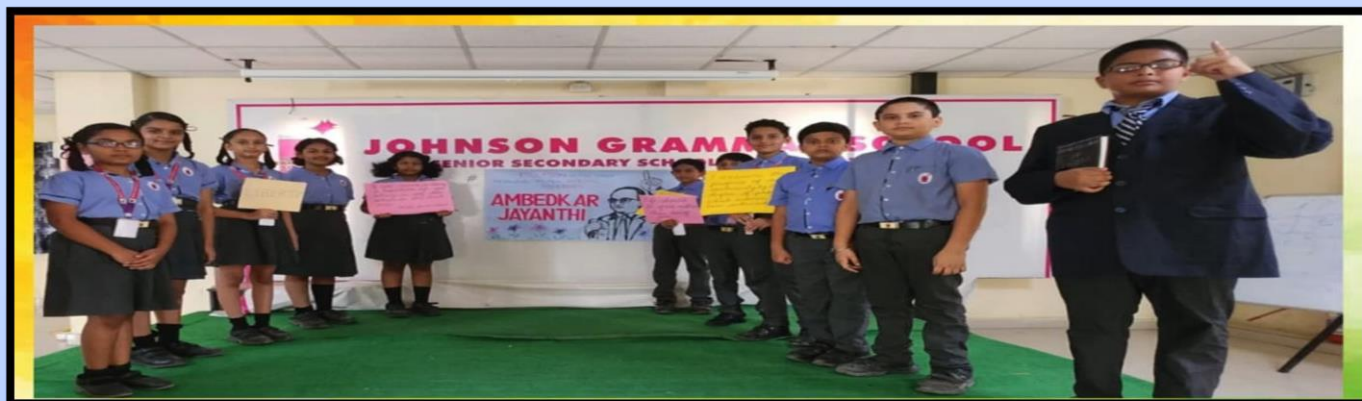
Students participated with great interest which showed their responsibility in protecting our Earth.
