BUT I DON'T NEED THEM AS LONG AS I HAVE YOU WITH ME.**

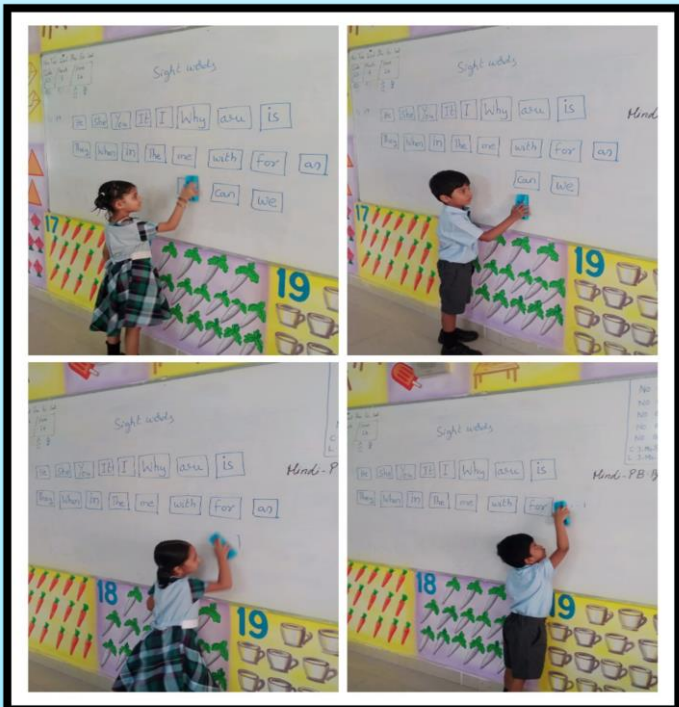
