“To love a rabbit is to understand the language of gentle hops and soft nose nudges”

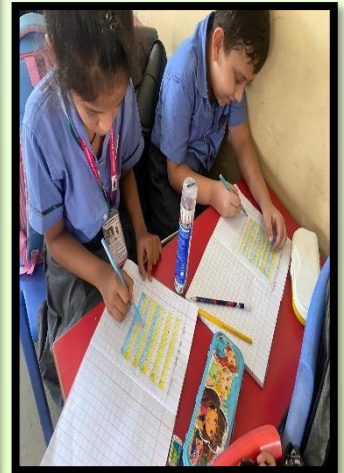
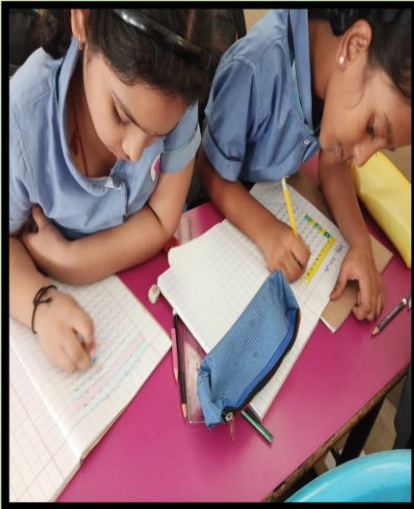

By making learning visual and interactive students are more likely to grasp and remember the properties of even and odd numbers. The teacher provided the number chart from 1 to 100 and discussed the differences between even and odd numbers then instructed the students to color all even numbers blue and the odd numbers red followed by pattern of sequences in the number chart. Through this activity students can develop their arithmetic skills , memory skills and shading skills .

YOGA DAY

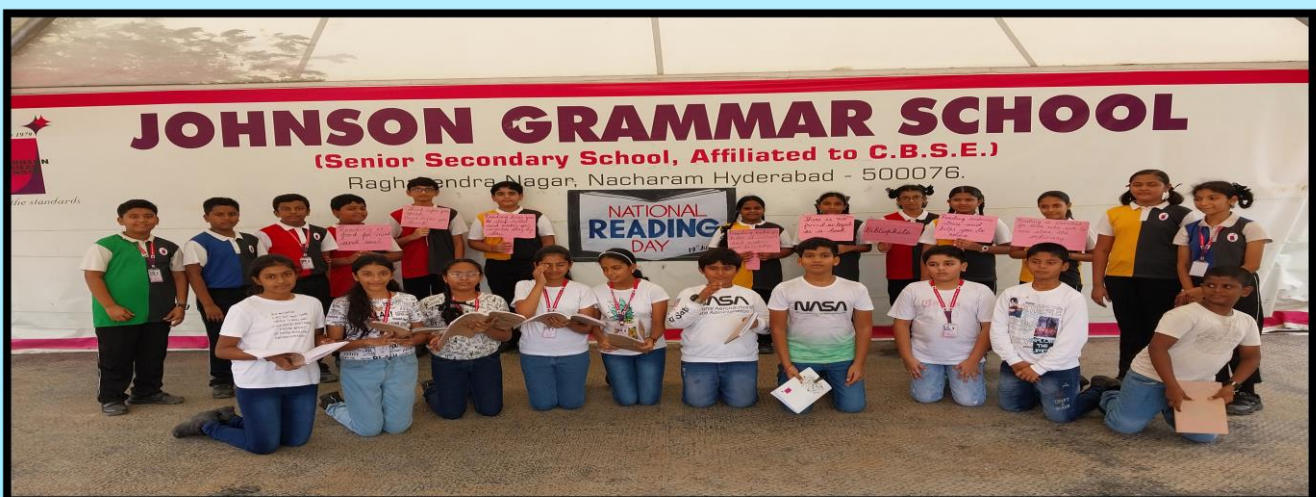
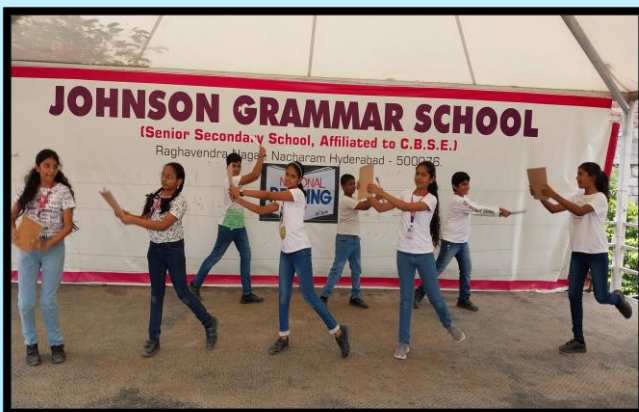

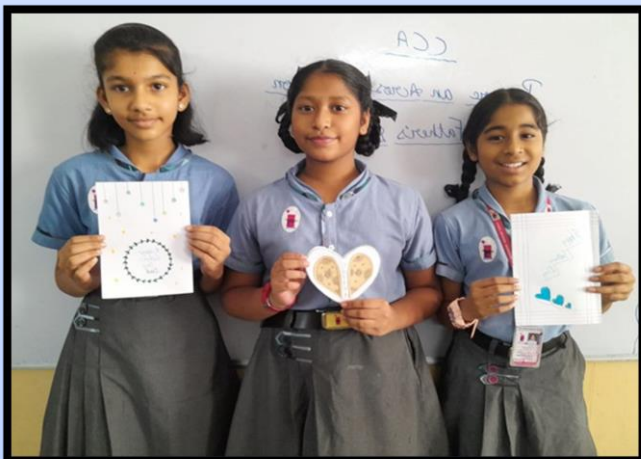


FATHER'S DAY (CCA)
