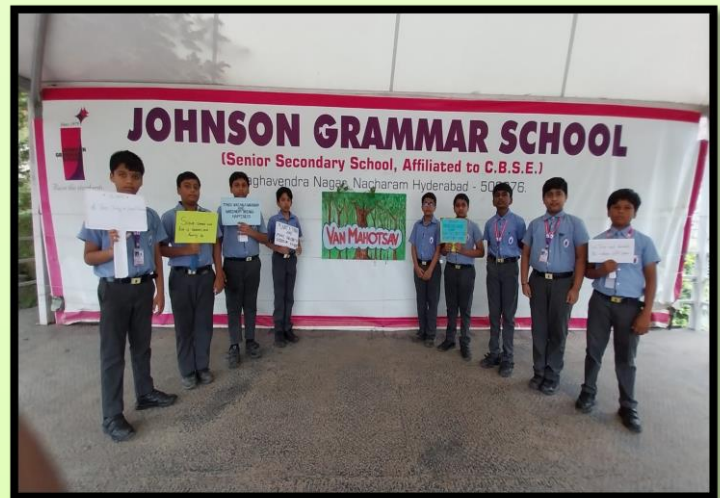


VAN MAHOTSAV

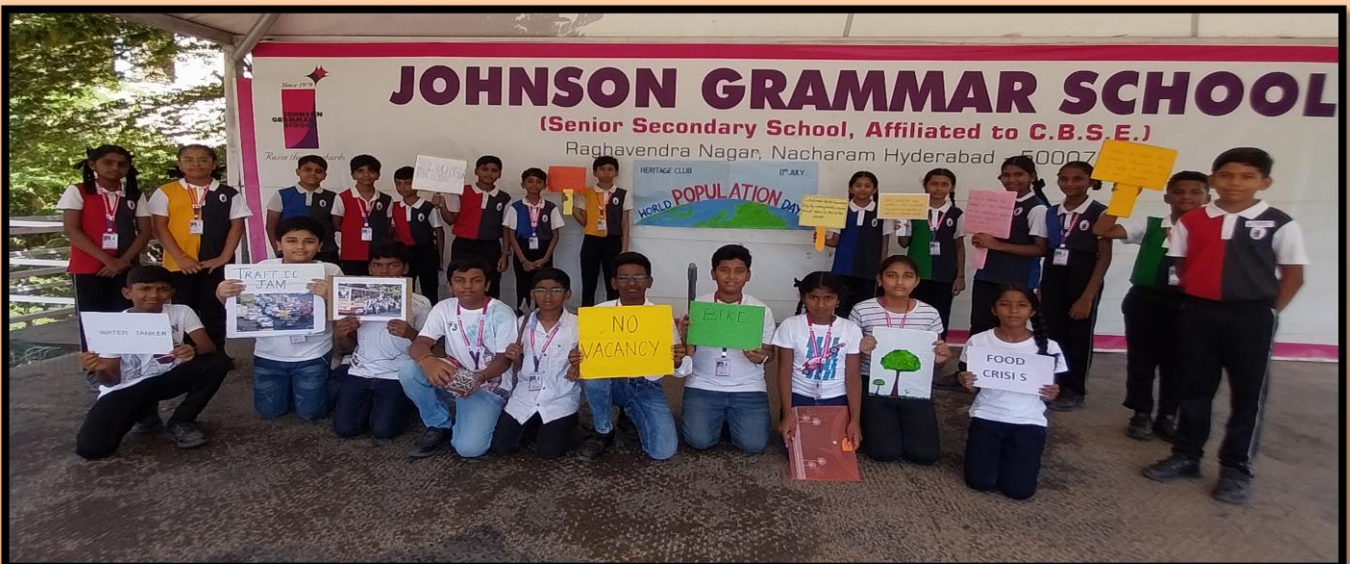
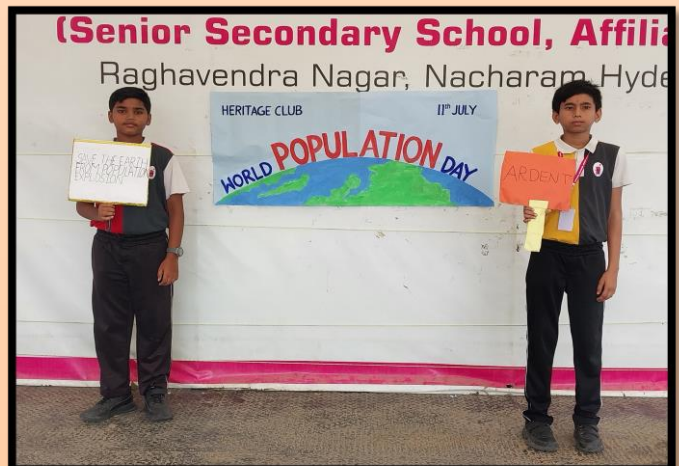
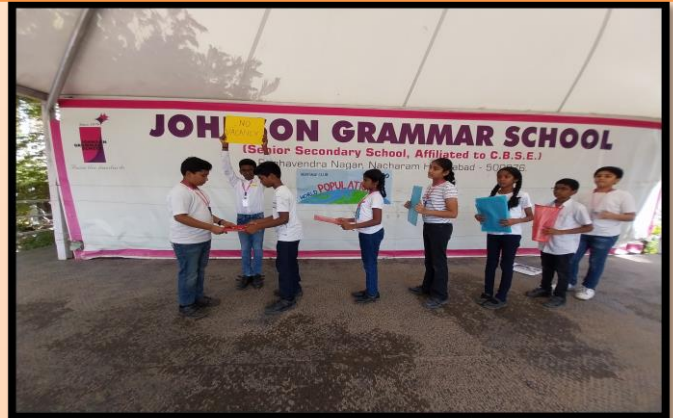


WORLD POPULATION DAY

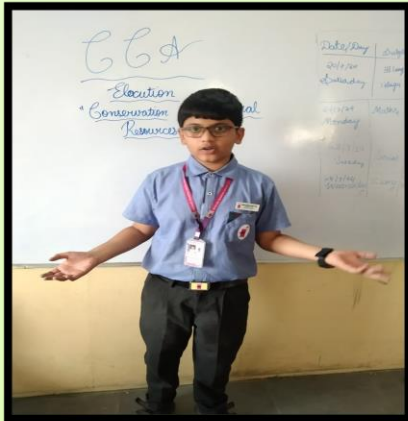
CONSERVATION OF NATURAL RESOURCES

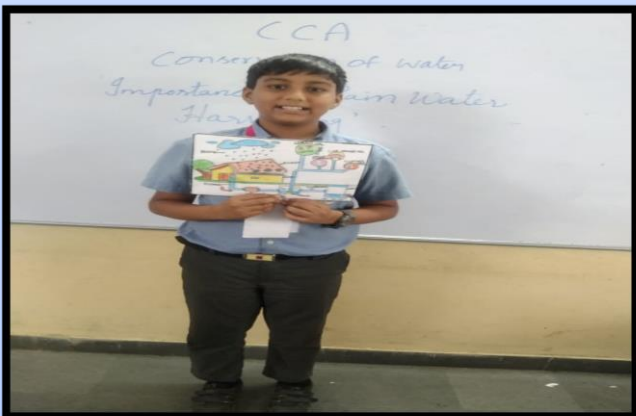


CONSERVATION OF WATER
