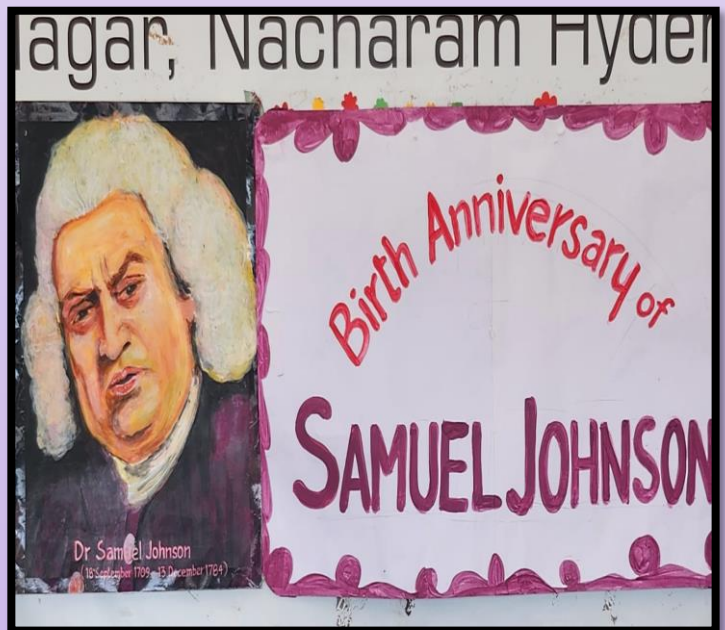


CELEBRATING SAMUEL JOHNSON'S BIRTH ANNIVERSARY
