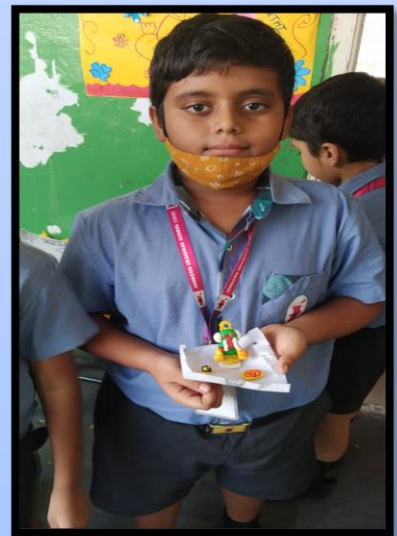


A CREATIVE FUSION
