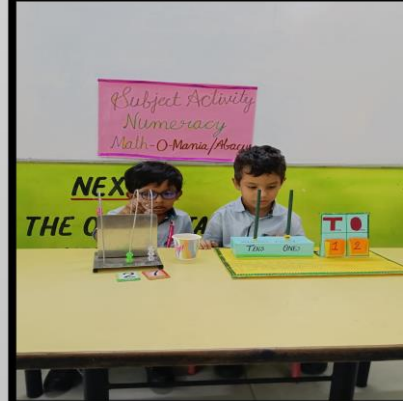
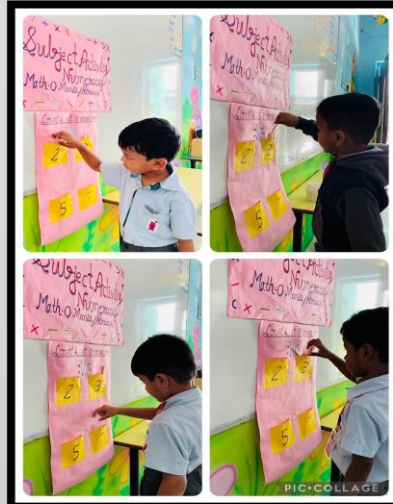
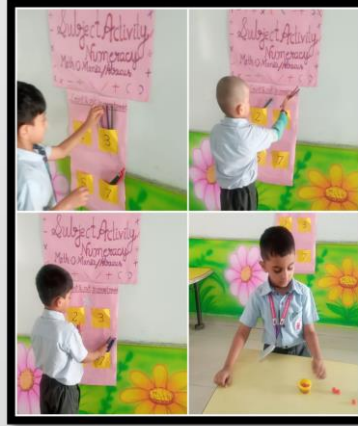


NUMERACY ACTIVITY
