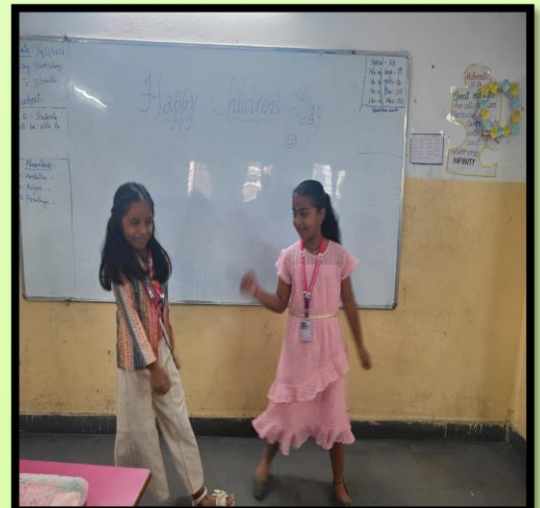
The perfect blend of generous giving, enchanting entertainment, and creative expression made the day an unforgettable experience for all.

"Every student has special talents. It is our duty and privilege to find these talents and to adapt our lessons to best implement them."

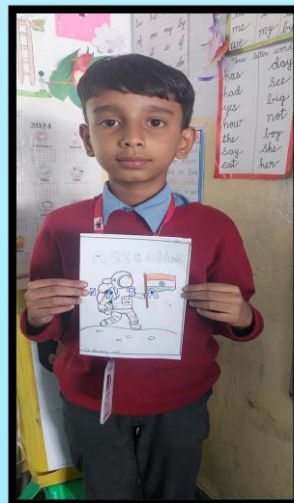
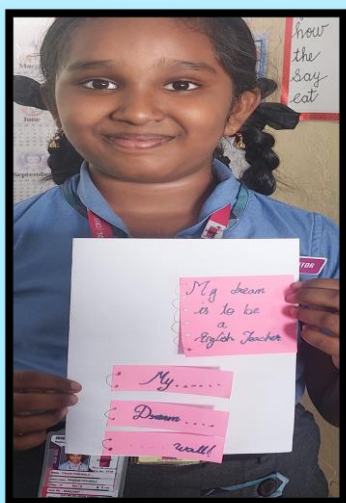
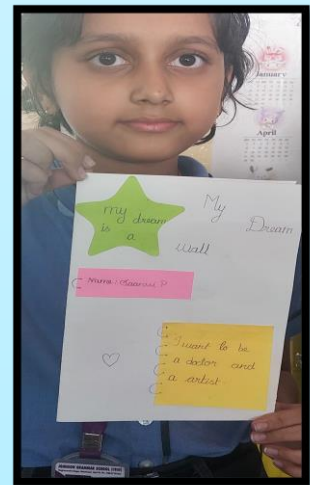
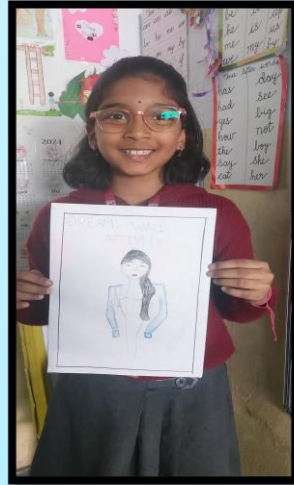

"The future belongs to those who believe in the beauty of their dreams."

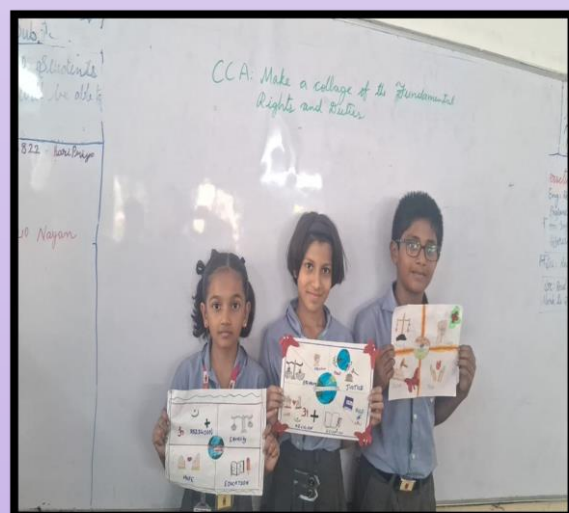
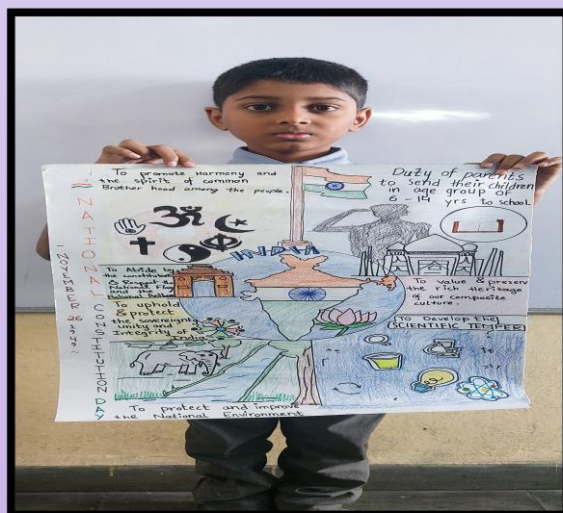
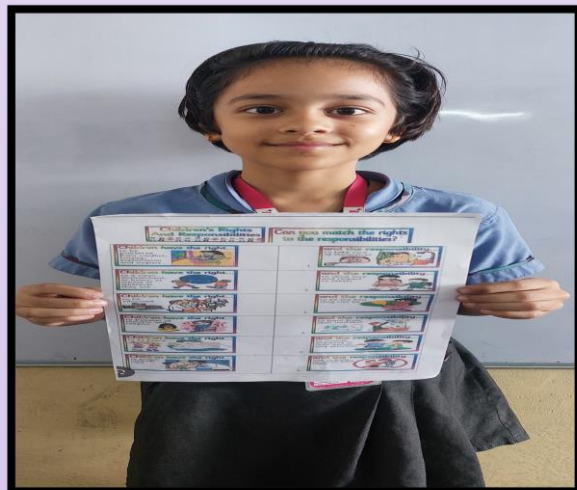
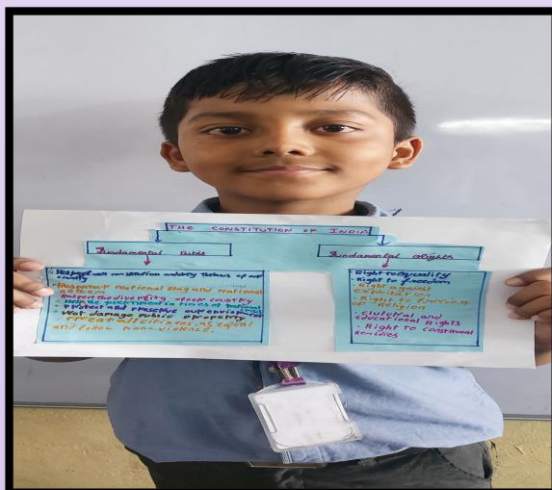
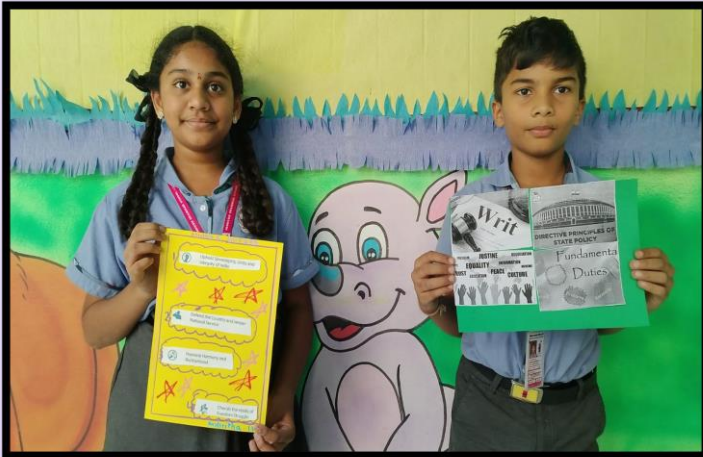
